

Health and Social Care Volunteering Fund

Description:

The Health and Social Care Volunteering Fund offers grant funding and business support for voluntary and community sector organisations aiming to enhance their capacity and ability in the health and social care fields. The Volunteering Fund replaces the Opportunities for Volunteering (OFV) scheme which supports local volunteering projects in health and social care, in addition to providing funding for national projects to improve health and wellbeing.

Common Ground Initiative

Description:

The Common Ground initiative is a £20 million fund, managed by Comic Relief and co-funded by the Department for International Development, supporting African development through UK based small and Diaspora organisations.

Culture Programme 2007 - 2013

Description:

The Culture Programme supports projects and initiatives aimed to celebrate Europe's cultural diversity and enhance the shared cultural heritage involving co-operation and collaboration of arts and cultural organisations from at least three eligible countries. Visiting Arts is the UK Cultural Contact Point (CCP) for the Culture Programme, which is administered by the European Commission.

Third Sector Strategic Partner Programme 2010/11

Description:

The Strategic Partner Programme aims to invest in a small number of strategic partners from April 2010-11 who will work collaboratively with the Department of Health in order to contribute to its strategic objectives.

European Refugee Fund

Description:

The European Refugee Fund (ERF) is mainly aimed at organisations involved in setting up projects that assist in the integration of refugees or people who have been granted humanitarian protection or discretionary leave to remain in the UK. ERF is open to local, regional or national organisations. The fund is administered by the Home Office UK Border Agency on behalf of the European Commission.

European Return Fund

Description:

The European Return Fund (RF) aims to support the efforts of European Union Member States to return migrants from outside Europe to their countries of origin. RF is open to local, regional or national organisations. The fund is administered by the Home Office UK Border Agency on behalf of the European Commission.

Community Voices

Description:

Media Trust are providing funding for projects using digital media to help empower disadvantaged communities.

European Integration Fund - Community Actions

Description:

The European Integration Fund - Community Actions offers financial support for projects promoting the integration in the EU Member States of people who are not citizens of the EU. Projects should be implemented through the coordination of a partnership and must include partners from at least five different Member States. Community Actions is a European Commission funding programme.

Independent Sexual Violence Advisors Fund

Description:

This grant programme funds the cost of existing or new Independent Sexual Violence Advisors (ISVAs) to address the safety of victims of sexual abuse. ISVAs work in partnership with Criminal Justice agencies, the voluntary sector and Victim and Witness Services. They provide support to clients, both those who access the criminal justice process and those who choose not to, helping them to live without fear of violence and access the services they need in the aftermath of the abuse they have experienced. Applications are invited from Sexual Assault Referral Centres, specialist sexual violence voluntary sector organisations, and existing ISVA services.

Victims Fund: Development of Services for Victims of Sexual Violence and Abuse

Description:

The Victims Fund supports the development of community based services for victims of sexual offending. For 2009/10 the fund aims to provide funding to voluntary sector services for all victims of sexual violence and abuse with the aim of ensuring the continuation of front-line services at risk of reduction or closure. The grant scheme is open to all existing voluntary sector organisations within England and Wales that provide support to victims of sexual violence and abuse.

Description:

European Social Fund Community Grants are small grants of up to £12,000 for voluntary and community organisations to help them reach disadvantaged people who are not in employment. The scheme is designed to make the European Social Fund (ESF) more accessible for groups without the capacity to apply for the main structural funds.
