What is Share Street?

- A new online community to connect everyone who works in the children and young people's workforce.
- A central place to:
 - add and access resources
 - to share best practice and overcome challenges
 - be connected



Why is it needed?

- 2020 Children and Young People Workforce Strategy advised CWDC to:
 - make it easier for people to communicate with each other and to access information, evidence and guidance
- This was supported by research from stakeholders, the Share! project and the bi-annual stakeholder survey that collectively requested:
 - a forum to share best practise and ask questions
 - a tool to disseminate resources more wide



What can I do on Share Street?



My house

- This is your personal area on Share Street.
- Store all the useful documents and videos you find.
- Search for registered colleagues and useful contacts and invite those not on Share Street to join.
- Exchange direct messages with colleagues and contacts.
- View alerts about new resources in the cinema, library and rainbow.



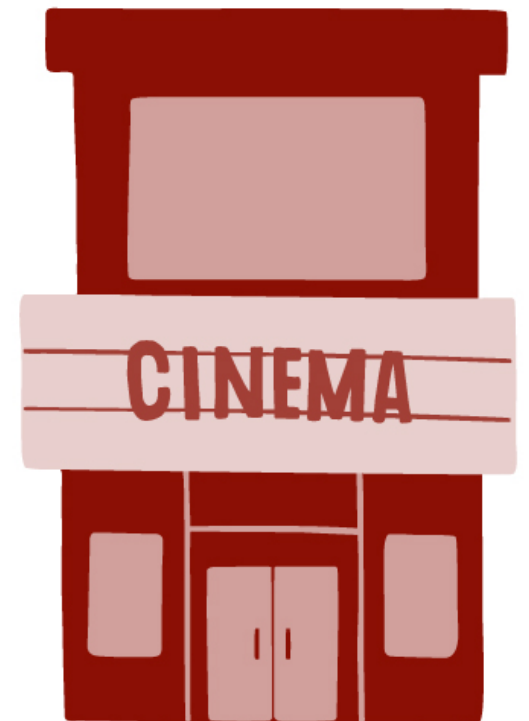
Café

- In the café you can network with colleagues and the wider workforce.
- Find the subjects most relevant to your work with children, young people and their families.
- Join discussions on a wide range of issues.
- Discuss topics with professionals from across the entire workforce.



Cinema

- Visit the cinema to watch inspiring films about workforce experiences.
- Search through the videos to find useful films for your area of work.
- Comment on or share the most useful items with colleagues.
- See which are the most popular films being watched.



Library

- Search for useful documents for your area of expertise.
- Add your resources here.
- Bookmark and share useful documents.
- Read and add comments posted about resources.



Newsagent

- Keep up to date with the latest news from the children and young people's workforce in the newsagent.
- Use the message board to leave your own notices.
- Browse through articles provided by CWDC and other newsfeeds.



Playground

- The playground is the where the voice of children and young people can be heard.
- View, download, bookmark and share videos, case studies and document content highlighting the children and young people's point of view of their workforce.



Rainbow

- Read inspiring case studies from the workforce – sharing stories of ongoing and overcoming challenges, achievements and best practice.
- Key case studies highlight work that has been done under each category of the rainbow.
